Tent Camping Checklist

■ Gear & Shelter

- Ground tarp or tent footprint

- Pillows and extra blankets

■ Cooking & Food

- Camp stove or portable grill with fuel
- Lighter, matches, or fire starter
- Cooler with ice or ice packs
- Prepped meals and non-perishable food
- Reusable plates, bowls, utensils, and cookware
- Can opener and cutting board
- Trash bags and paper towels

■ Water & Hydration

- Filled water jugs or containers
- Personal water bottles or hydration packs
- Biodegradable soap and dish sponge

■ Lighting & Safety

- Flashlights or headlamps (with extra batteries)
- Lantern for tent or picnic table
- First aid kit
- Insect repellent and sunscreen

■ Clothing & Personal Care

- Weather■appropriate clothing (layers, rain gear, extra socks)
- Towel and toiletries
- Hand sanitizer and wet wipes

■ Comfort & Fun

- Camp chairs and folding table
- Books, cards, or travel games
- Activity gear (fishing rod, swimming gear, etc.)
- Camera or phone with charger

■ Extras & Essentials

- Area map or printed park information
- Small amount of cash for firewood, snacks, or emergencies
- Emergency contact list or phone numbers
